PADI Open Water Diver Course

If you are 10 years of age or older, the PADI Open Water Diver Course gives you the freedom to dive with a buddy, independent of a dive professional. Your course covers the fundamentals of scuba diving including dive equipment and techniques, through self study and small group training sessions using state of the art training materials

Pool and Classroom Training – Phase 1

\$250.00 – Group Training (4-6 students maximum)

Your dive training begins by completing a 1 hour Discover Scuba Dive in the pool. Your Open Water Diver Course will then continue with 4 additional pool dives and classroom training sessions following either an evening or a weekend schedule. The evening schedule allows you to complete your training over 4 weeks while the weekend schedule can be completed over 1 or 2 weekend. For added flexibility you can begin your training with one course and finish it with another to suit your schedule. For more demanding schedules, we may be able to design a private schedule – call for pricing and details.

Your course fee includes your OW Crew Pack (\$93.04) which includes your PADI OW Diver Manual, diver log book pages, electronic RDP for planning dives, use of OW DVD and rental of scuba gear for pool training. You just need to provide your own personal snorkeling equipment which will vary depending on if you are diving locally or away. Highly discounted student packages are available.

Don't have time for the classroom sessions – take the e-learning option – complete your classroom training anywhere, anytime online. E-Learning classroom training is \$120 US and your pool training & e-student kit (e-RDP & log book) is \$150 Canadian (or \$270 Canadian if you combine your pool training & e-student kit with your Open Water Certification dives (Phase 2).

Open Water Certification Dives – Phase 2

Locally: \$150.00 On a DNL Dive Trip: No Charge

You will need to do a minimum of 4 open water dives for certification. You can either complete these on your vacation if you are traveling down south, join us on one of our dive vacations to do your dives at no additional charge, or finish your open water certification dives locally.

Newfoundland has some of the best diving in Canada and DNL provides you with the most enjoyable experience possible. All scuba equipment, ***INCLUDING A DRYSUIT*** during the winter months to ensure your warmth and comfort, will be provided. In addition to the scuba equipment rental, your fees include 4 Open Water dives, certification fees, and either a Drysuit Adventure Dive (Winter) or a Digital UW Photo Dive (Summer) is included at no additional charge.
